Dear Parent/Carer,

P7 Buddies

The P7 buddies will continue to meet the P1 children next week at the gate until they are fully familiar with our playground. The P7 children are doing a great job supporting the younger children in the morning and at lunchtime. Well done P7!

P1 snacks

Please could we ask all P1 parents to send their children wearing their coat with a snack in their pocket? There has been some confusion this week with snacks in lunch boxes so hopefully snacks in pockets will make it easier.

Uniform

We are very keen to encourage the wearing of full school uniform in Halyrude as this ensures everyone is the same and there is no competition over the latest trainers etc. It is also good preparation for uniform expectations at high school. We would like to thank all our families for supporting this; it is lovely to see the children looking so smart in their uniforms.

We have had some questions about PE kit. If children wish to bring trainers on a Thursday for outdoor PE we are happy with this, gym shoes must be worn in the gym hall. If you have not purchased gym shoes yet please do so as soon as you are able to.

Leadership Roles

Over the next few weeks, the children in the upper school will be given leadership roles such as Pupil Council, House Captains, Playground leaders etc. We look forward to working with the children in these roles.

Parents in the Playground

A reminder that although the restrictions in wider society have relaxed, this is not the case in school. Please can we remind all parents that only one parent from P1/2 should be in the front playground to drop off/pick up children? In the morning, please drop your child off at the gate and then leave the playground so that children can make their way to our playground and to Rosetta.

At the end of the day, please wait by the cones so that the path is clear for children in P3 – 7 to make their way to their parents waiting on the pavement. Staff will release children one by one to waiting parents waiting by the cones.

If you wish to meet up with friends before and after school, please do so away from school. The reason the restrictions are in place in school is to do as much as we can to protect children and staff from the virus and keep our schools open and running normally. We would very much appreciate your support with following the regulations we have in place. Thank you.

Snacks in School

On the in-service day, all staff engaged in choke training. One of the greatest risks of choking is grapes, especially when children are running around. Please could we ask that you cut up grapes from top to bottom to reduce this risk? Thank you.
