Rights Respecting Schools

We are also able to refer you to Tweed Togs. This is a confidential service, so your name is not shared. Tweed Togs can provide bags of high quality second hand clothing for your children including those not yet at school. The clothes are then delivered to school for you to collect at a time that suits you.

We have a stock of good quality second hand school uniform in school, please let us know if you require anything.

We are aware of the high cost of energy just now and the Parent Council have kindly paid for more chargers so that if required, your child can charge their iPad in school.

You were sent details yesterday via email about an app run by the NHS called Money Worries.

Breakfast club is open every day from 8.30 until 8.45 if children have not had the chance to have breakfast for whatever reason.
